RE: Responsibilities of Voting Delegates

As a chapter voting delegate at the State Leadership Conference, you hold many responsibilities. Your most important role is to choose the best candidates for state office and to vote for those individuals at the Delegate Assembly. By getting to know your candidates better, you can help make the best decision for your chapter's vote for next year's State Officer Team.

The following are a few tips and responsibilities to remember while fulfilling your role as a Local Voting Delegate at this year's State Leadership Conference:

- Listen to the candidate speeches during the Opening General Session
- Visit the campaign booths during the conference
- Talk with candidates and ask specific questions
- Look at the candidate brochures and ask questions
- Help your chapter develop questions for the Formal Caucus
- Attend the Formal Caucus and listen to the candidates' responses
- Vote during the Primary Ballot
- Attend Delegate Assembly
- Wear your name badge

You will want to meet with your chapter members prior to the Primary Ballot to determine the candidates who will receive your chapter's votes. By holding a chapter meeting, all members can take part in the election process. All chapter members should visit the campaign booths, ask questions, and most importantly, help choose the candidates they think should serve on next year's State Officer Team.

Your responsibility at the conference is to vote during the Primary Ballot and to vote during Delegate Assembly. Roll is taken at both voting sessions!

Primary Ballot Voting: Friday, 2:30 – 5 p.m., Palace Foyer

Delegate Assembly: Friday, 6 to 7 p.m., Heartland Room
